Rick,

You are correct. The summary analysis by the Ecology attorney (and I am paraphrasing) is that agencies have only the authorities that are expressly granted or necessarily implied by statute. Ecology does not have express or implied statutory authority to become a member of a non-profit corporation, as proposed in the draft documents.

However, Ecology can participate in the SRRTTF since it relates to Ecology's responsibilities under the CWA. This can be done without being a member of a non-profit corporation.

Hi Adriane

As you suggested, we sent off the MOA to our AG's office for their consultation. Our Senior Counsel recommended that DOH not be a signatory to the MOA or more accurately, to remove our agency from the MOA. Our take on this is that DOH serves in a consultative role insofar as issues relate to human health concerns. However, SRRTFF is not a legislatively established entity and DOH does not have clear statutory authority to become a member of a nonprofit entity that includes private members. This conclusion is reinforced by the fact that members will be assessed dues and DOH does not have clear statutory authority to pay such dues and would not control the amount of the dues.

Therefore, our Senior Counsel recommends that DOH submit comments on the proposal pointing out that DOH cannot become a member of the entity, but would appreciate the opportunity to continue in its consultative role. If you don't believe that role is sufficient under the proposed new structure, we can discuss other alternatives, such as having DOH representatives serve as ex officio members, but those measures may be unnecessary.
