Hi Adriane,

I spoke with our agency's Attorneys General office regarding the SRRTTF letter regarding the TSCA bill and they, along with Ecology's Attorneys General have some concerns over the unintended consequences the letter may have. The new TSCA bill would supposedly shield Monsanto from responsibility for PCBs. DOH and Ecology have been working with them on PCBs and TSCA reform and they don't think the law can be read this way. If the bill language does not give Monsanto immunity, then SRRTTF shouldn't send a letter about it. The letter would give more legitimacy to the claim that the language does give Monsanto immunity.

I will not be able to attend tomorrow's conference call but wanted to share our concerns with the groups. Please pass this along. As a voting member, DOH would vote no on sending out the letter its current form.
