### Spokane River Forum- Spring Media Campaign: (Andy)

- We had some discussion about the Spring 2020 media campaign.
  - What do we want to do for the campaign?
  - Do we want to keep the same messaging? Andy didn't think the messages should change that much.
    - ACTION ITEM: Vikki will email Tonilee to get the current content and messaging that was used for this year's campaign. Once Vikki gets the content, she will send it out to E&O members to look at and see if there is anything that we want to change or add.
  - What distribution platforms do we want to go with?
    - Radio (good for general awareness, not a strong correlation with the waste directory because they cannot click on the ad like Facebook)
    - Pandora (don't think we should do this next time)
    - Facebook/Instagram
    - Pre-roll messaging
  - Direction from the task force on what direction they would like to go.
- Andy mentioned that the River Forum got a recycle right grants and there will be updates to the waste directory. How can we harmonize all the different platforms, organizations? There will be a recycling task force starting.

## **IPCB Workshop Discussion:**

- Lisa gave an update from the IPCB workshop and some education and outreach items that came from the workshop.
  - How do we educate the public?
  - How do we educate corporate level/business outreach?
- E&O goal:
  - Educate the users in the supply stream- Ink/Pigment Manufacturers
    - How do we get to those people?
    - Start with the packaging people- they will go upstream and put pressure on their suppliers. If some start doing it, others may follow.
    - We can work with the Sustainable packaging coalition and NW Green Chemistry.
