## October 2022 Update

### ❖ Highlights

- TTWG (10/18) topics included:
  - 1) Hamilton Street monitoring well data – determined path forward for collection and analysis
  - 2) Next Level Historical Review – Many comments, a final draft will be provided on November 4
  - 3) Fish Trend Assessment – WDFW will collect fish this fall
  - 4) Groundwater and surface water fingerprinting of PCB data at GE Site (TTWG recommendation to approve scope and budget today – 45K)
  - 5) Compilation of Groundwater Monitoring Well Data (to be discussed further at November TTWG, may include Hamilton Street Bridge well data analysis in this work)
- Additional SRRTTF Projects - TTWG encouraged to bring project ideas to the table prior to November mtg

- Today – Recommend approval of LimnoTech scope and budget for PCB Fingerprinting Analysis of GE site groundwater –
- November TF
  - Approval of Spokane River Historical PCB Source Review Memo (currently being updated by TTWG)
  - Possible project approval – Compilation of monitoring well data to assess connectivity to SR (including Hamilton Street Bridge data from data loggers)
  - Possible project approval – Next steps for high scoring sites from historical review
  - Possible project approval – Additional Canine Detection Work (likely later)

## ❖ Project Updates from the Field

- All field work has been completed with the exception of the fish collection for fish trend assessment (which will occur this fall) and the winter moderate flow SPMD deployment. SPMDs for summer low flow sampling were retrieved at the end of September.

  - Pigment resource being finalized
  - Demonstration and approval at November SRRTTF Meeting
- Safer Products WA – SRRTTF Actions TBD @ November iPCB/TSCA Meeting
- Working on 2022 Project Proposals:
  - Petition EPA to evaluate impacts of iPCB TSCA allowance (cost/benefit, risk & rule congruity)
  - Opportunity to work with EPA on testing of TiO<sub>2</sub>
