- SRRTTF Sunsets
- EPA completes Spokane River PCB TMDL
- Ecology establishes Advisory Group for TMDL implementation
- Ecology completes PCB TMDL Implementation Plan



Roles and Responsibilities

- Community (advises Ecology)
- EPA (writes the TMDL)
- Ecology (writes the Implementation Plan)
- Ecology Implements the TMDL*
- *Ability to conduct implementation tasks contingent on funding and staffing

- Autonomous
- MOA
- Studies defined by TF
- Measurable Progress
- Public and private funding
- Business structure

Ecology Advisory Group

- Established by agency
- Recommends implementation actions
- Group sets Ground Rules
- Ecology is main authority and decision maker
- State funded


Pathway to an Implementation Plan (IP) (Normal process)

Advisory Committee (2024) IP Complete (2 years) (2026)








Pathway to an Implementation Plan Task Force does not sunset







MOA transition tasks

- "Decision to sunset" memo signed by all parties/TF vote
- Amendment
 - Mutually agreed upon
 - Signed by all parties
- Individual parties, other than permittees
 - Notify and submit to remaining members



SRRTTF Transition Items: Ecology Review

CONCUR

- Finalize outstanding contract items (reports)
- Contract ends June 30, 2023
- Websites: Some might be maintained with Ecology pass through funding
- Outreach activities could continue
- ACE administration tasks and close out, responsibility of ACE

TO BE DISCUSSED (based on regulatory need, funding or advice)

- Partial outstanding/unfinished work (Ecology discretion)
- Data collection and work after July 1, 2023 (advocate for in the Advisory Group)
- SRRTTF website would be archived/replaced with Ecology Advisory Group website
- EIM would be the primary database
